

COLORADO HIGH COUNTRY RANCH TOUR

MAY 23-29, 2010



We will start our tour in Denver, CO, on May 23, 2010, and will stay at the Sheraton Downtown Denver Hotel, located on the 16th Street Mall. Registration begins at 2:00 on Sunday and at 6:00 p.m. we host a "Meet and Greet" for the group with cocktails and dinner.

Monday we head for the Colorado High Country, stopping at Mike Ritschard's multi-generation ranch in the Kremmling area on our way to Steamboat Springs. We will stay at the Steamboat Grand hotel for the next three nights.

Tuesday, we will venture west to Craig, CO, and the Raftopoulos Ranch, a unique operation that utilizes AI for their entire cow herd. Wednesday we head to the famous North Park area. At 9,000 feet elevation and with breathtaking views in every direction, we will see firsthand what high country ranching is all about. We'll visit with Don Culver at the Owl Creek Ranch and Danny and Lucy Meyring at Meyring Livestock Company. Nancy and Jerry Meyring, Danny's brother, have been guests on several of our tours.

Thursday we leave Steamboat and stop in at Rossi Ranch, a multi-generation ranch, as well as Nottingham Ranch, perhaps one of the most gorgeous ranches in Colorado. Our next stop is Glenwood Springs where we stay for the next two nights. We will be in the historic Colorado Hotel, with the famous mineral hot springs at the front door of the hotel. Friday we head up the Roaring Fork Valley to stop at Tybar Angus Ranch and then spend a couple hours in Aspen.

Saturday we have a special treat at the Crystal River Ranch, one of the largest contiguous ranches in the valley. We head back to Denver on Saturday and finish our tour at 5:00 p.m. Your Saturday night stay is included in the price. You will be able to receive the tour rate at the Sheraton if you arrive a few days early.

We have several ranch calls and other surprises lined up as well, so reserve your place now! Springtime ranching in the Colorado High Country is an experience you won't want to miss! If you fly, plan your trip into Denver International Airport. We end the tour on Memorial Day weekend, so plan your flights early! We look forward to seeing you again!
